



WHY PLANT A CHURCH?

IS IT NEEDED?

The most generous estimates suggest that only 7% of the Australian population attend church (NCLS). This means Sydney (population 5.3 million) could have as few as 371,000 people attending church (at least monthly) and 4.9 million people who desperately need Jesus.

From 1991-2016 Australia saw a net loss of around 1200 churches, yet in that same period of time our national population grew by almost 7 million. We need hundreds of new Jesus-worshipping, disciple-making, church-planting churches if we hope to reach this city and nation with the good news that Jesus is King.

The National Church Life Survey (NCLS) from 2021 tells us that for every 100 adult church attendees:

- Y 10% are aged 15−29;
- Y 22% are aged 30−49;
- Y 32% are aged 50−69; and
- Y 36% are aged 70+
- Y More than two thirds of church attendees in Australia are over 50!

The average age of a church attendee in our nation is 53 and younger demographics are increasingly under-represented. The Australian church is ageing and this is a crucial moment for Christianity in our nation. Despite this reality, we see tremendous opportunities to reach the emerging generations with the Gospel!

According to the data, nearly 10% of young adults who currently attend church are newcomers without any previous church background. This is almost double the amount compared to every other age group. This means, that while the emerging generations are under-represented in overall church numbers, they have an openness to the Gospel that should fill us with optimism as we boldly plant new churches!

IS IT EFFECTIVE?

New churches have energy, momentum, a high sense of ownership, and heightened awareness of the urgency to reach people with the Gospel. Additionally, the National Church Life Survey tells us that new churches score higher on every measure of church health compared to established churches.





WHY PLANT A CHURCH IN THE NORTH SHORE (CHATSWOOD)?

The North Shore is a diverse region of Sydney made up of seven different local government areas, and with a population of over half a million.

It is a place of abundant material affluence and deep spiritual need.


Our target area, Chatswood and its surrounding suburbs, is home to over 100,000 people alone, who deeply need to encounter the sacrificial love of Jesus.

We believe Chatswood is the location God is leading us to plant this church. It is a strategic location: a bustling, multicultural hub of people, culture, and a major business and residential district. Chatswood is culturally diverse; only 11% of residents have Australian ancestry compared to the national average of 30%. It is also deeply irreligious; a staggering 47% of residents identify as having 'no religion', which is almost 15% higher than the state average (32.8%). A higher proportion of young adults also live in Chatswood and the surrounding suburbs when compared with state and national averages.

There are exciting gospel opportunities in this area, and we look forward to partnering with existing churches in doing whatever it takes to bring the wayward home.

Our Launch Team is currently meeting in an apartment living room on the outskirts of Chatswood, and we are praying that God would open up a suitable venue for us in our target location in His timing.



1. PRAYER
